

YETI GROUP PROGRAMS

Youth Empowered Towards Independence (YETI) provides various programs for young people. Before authorising attendance at these programs, the following needs to be understood.

The Activities & Group programs aim at getting participants completing tasks which foster an increase in self esteem, personal confidence, heightened responsibilities and the inclusion in a healthy drug free life style.

On these programs YETI will be running many activities that may be physically, socially and emotionally demanding. These programs will include participation in activities away from YETI's premises.

The purpose of this document is to authorise Youth Empowered Towards Independence (YETI) to take young people on these programs during the year 2007. By signing this form you hereby authorize your child to attend these YETI programs and to participate in the activities.

By signing this form you understand that certain risks and dangers may exist such as (but not limited to) loss or damage to personal property, injury or fatality. In addition, you acknowledge that while staff will make every reasonable effort to minimise risks, not all danger associated with the activities can be foreseen. You accept the fact that while program staff is skilled and experienced, they cannot guarantee your child's safety since some risks are beyond their control.

By signing this form you are also agreeing that your child can participate in YETI programs, and that you agree to notify staff of any health and fitness issues, which may occur before, or during the program. Should your child become ill or be injured, consent is given to the program staff to provide or arrange for provision of medical services as they see fit. By signing this form you also agree to pay for any such treatment or medical advice if required.

I consent for the program supervisor to obtain appropriate medical attention in the event of an accident or illness and I undertake to pay for any such treatment or medical advice if required, including air transfers and/or rescue services. I understand that I will be informed at the earliest reasonable opportunity

I hereby consent to my child's participation in YETI's programs in 2007, including travel. I understand that the outdoor nature of some of the programs may involve risks. I understand that appropriate information will be provided to participants before they participate in the activity and they may choose their own level of participation.
